OPPORTUNITIES TO EARN VOLUNTEER HOURS FOR THE ACADEMIC VILLAGE CAMPUS

As you are aware, every family with students attending the Pembroke Pines Charter Schools are required to earn 30 parent volunteer hours “each” year the student(s) attends.

The following is a list of available ways to earn your volunteer hours during the school year:

Donations – Donations will be accepted. Parents will give hours for service provided on donations (e.g. travel time).

Regional Library

The Regional Library is open evenings and weekends, you may earn volunteer hours there as well. See Ms. Oltmans, Media Specialist, 2nd floor library.

Athletics

Be aware that coaches/boosters are NOT going to keep track of your hours. ***Parents are responsible for obtaining volunteer forms, getting them signed and turned into the office.***

Field Trips/Student Activities

Check with Student Activities Coordinator or Teacher sponsor. Driver’s license required for background check.

Advisory Meetings – Hours earned are based on the length of the meeting.

Advisory meetings are held every 2nd Monday of every month in the Library auditorium or Cafeteria and begin at 6:00pm. Scheduled meetings will be posted on the school website, under the link “Parent Advisory.”
