
Arrival Procedures

- Arrive no earlier than 8:10 AM.
- Student drop off is in the back of the campus by the gym until 8:35 AM.
- Students are not allowed to exit the vehicle until supervision is at the entry gate.

Dismissal Procedures


- Students must leave promptly after school.

 - Parents are **not** allowed to exit their vehicle.




