

10th Grade Dual Enrollment **Initial** Eligibility Criteria (Updated 8/19/25)

- Students **MUST** have at least a 3.0 unweighted gpa
To have a GPA student must have already taken a high school level course in middle school.
- **Minimum** College-level test scores or College Readiness using Alternative Methods of Placement in all areas - **Writing/English, Reading, and Math**

MAC1105 Eligibility Requirements

Common Placement Tests:

- ACCUPLACER Next Generation QAS (*on or after 10/25/2022*) = 267-300
- SAT Math Test (*on or before 3/8/2024*) = 26.5-40
- Digital SAT Math Section (*on or after 11/1/2021*) = 530-800
- ACT Math = 21-36

10th Grade Continued Eligibility Criteria

- Complete a Dual Enrollment Recommendation Form each term with parent/legal guardian, student, school counselor, and principal signatures
- Maintain a 3.0 unweighted high school GPA
- Maintain a 2.0 Broward College GPA
- Earn a grade of "C" or better in each college course
- Dual Enrolled and Early Admission students who receive a "D" or "F" grade are no longer eligible to participate in the program.
